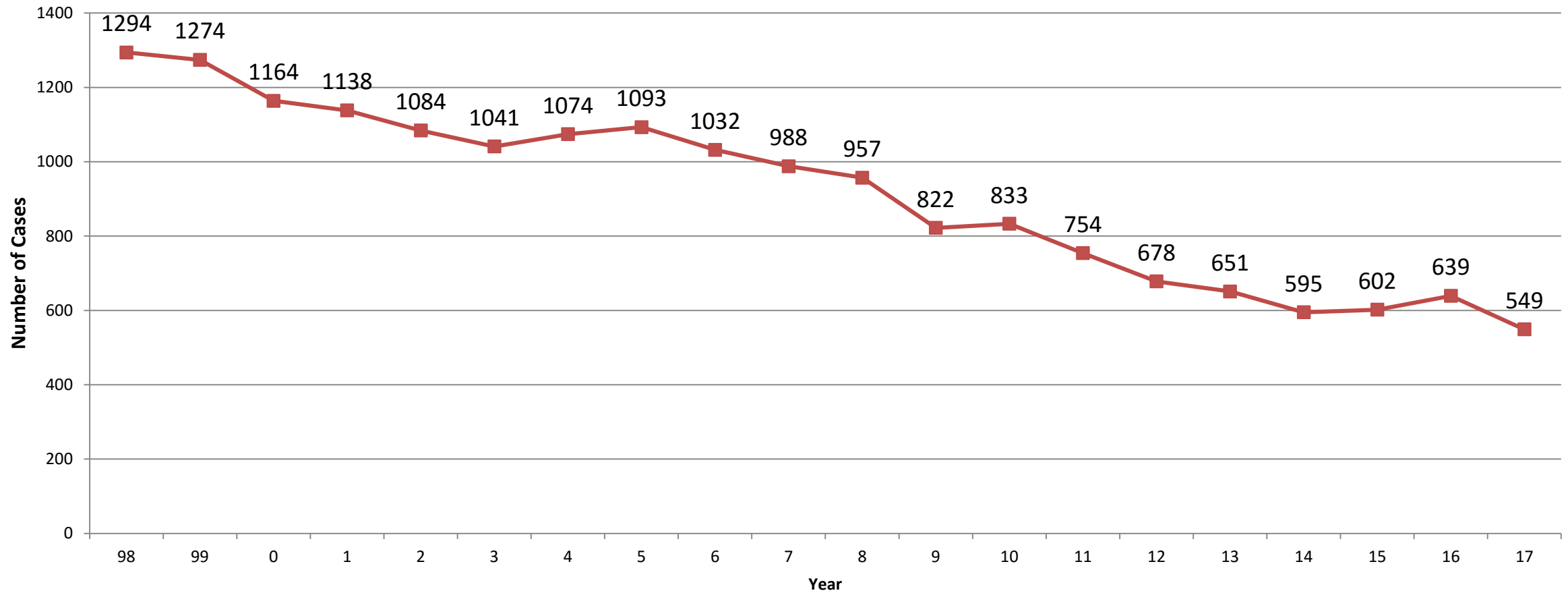

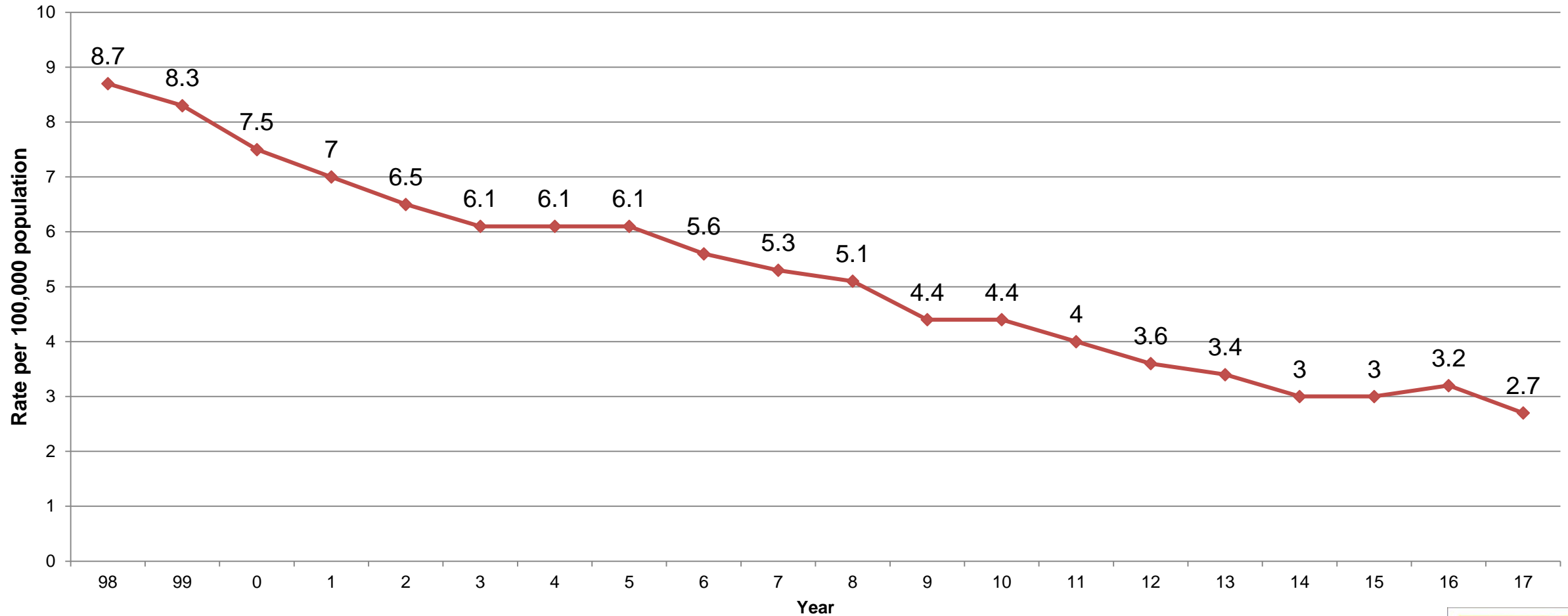

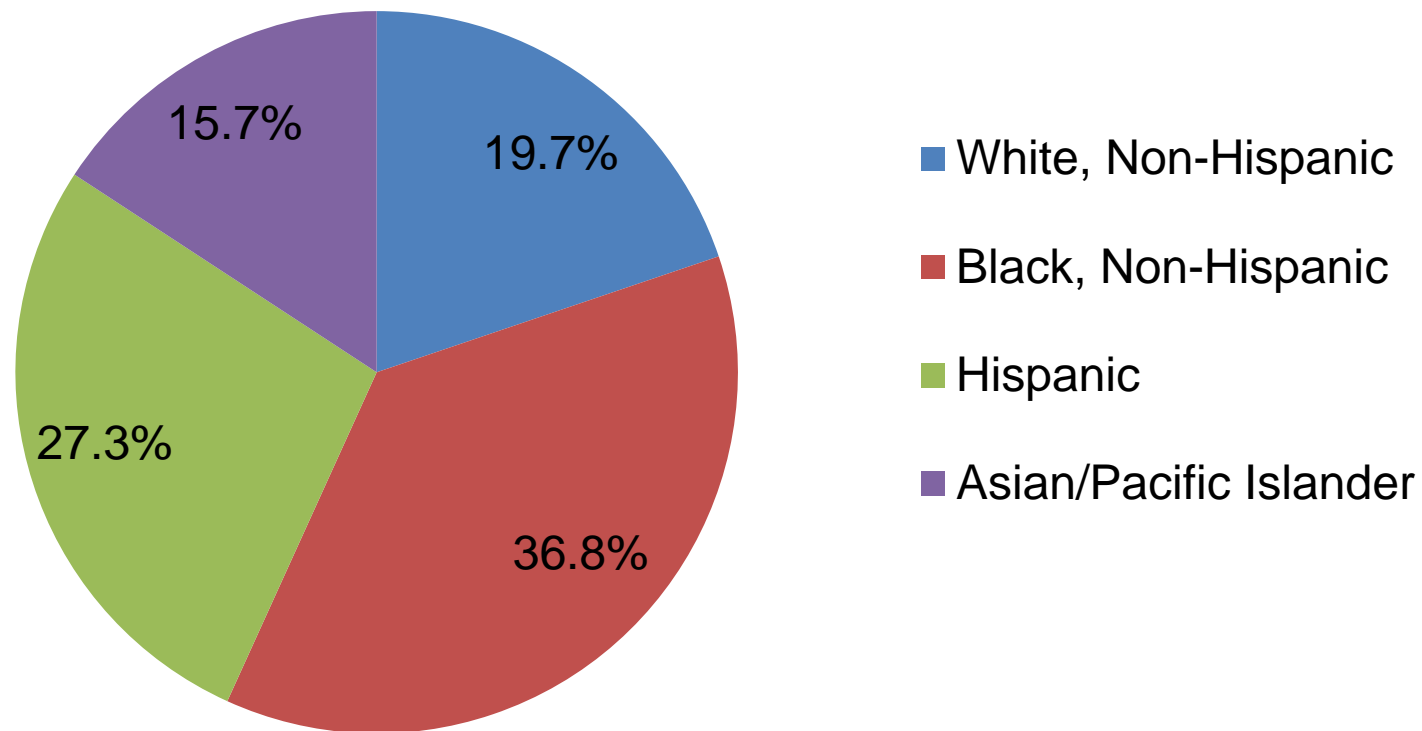

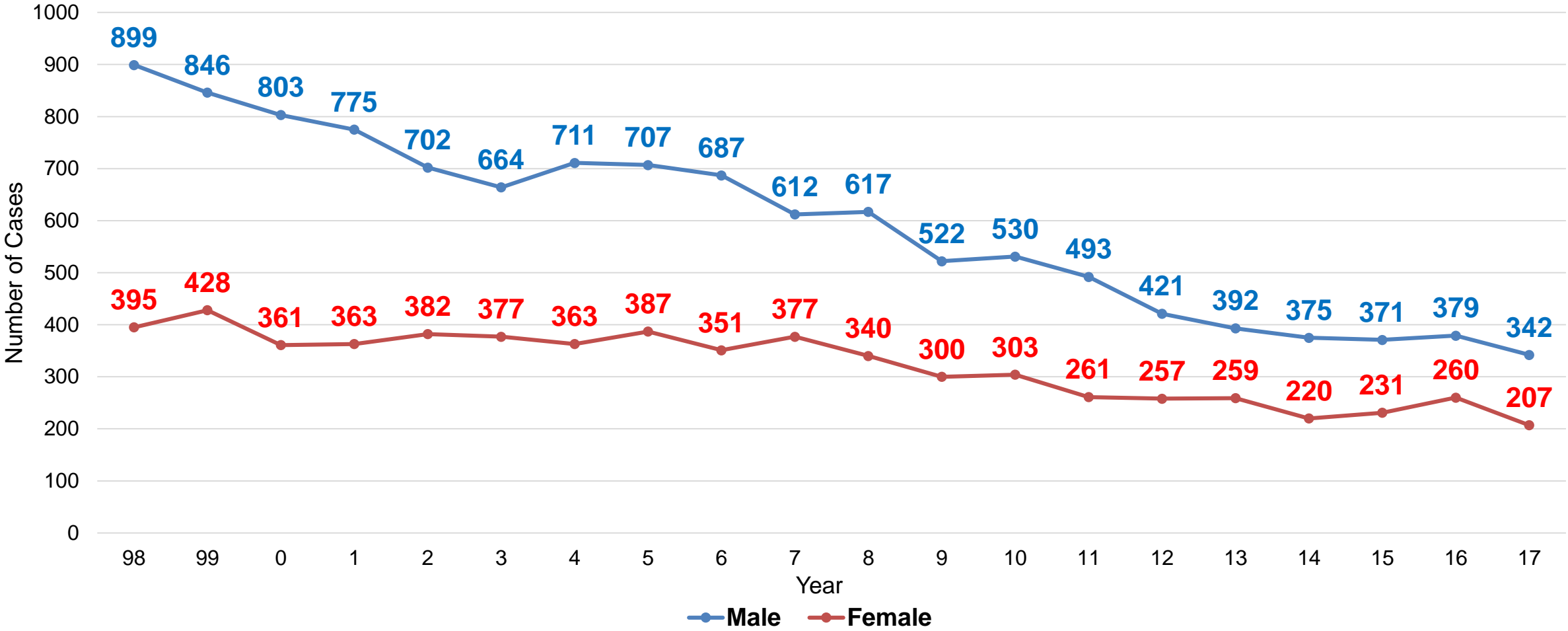

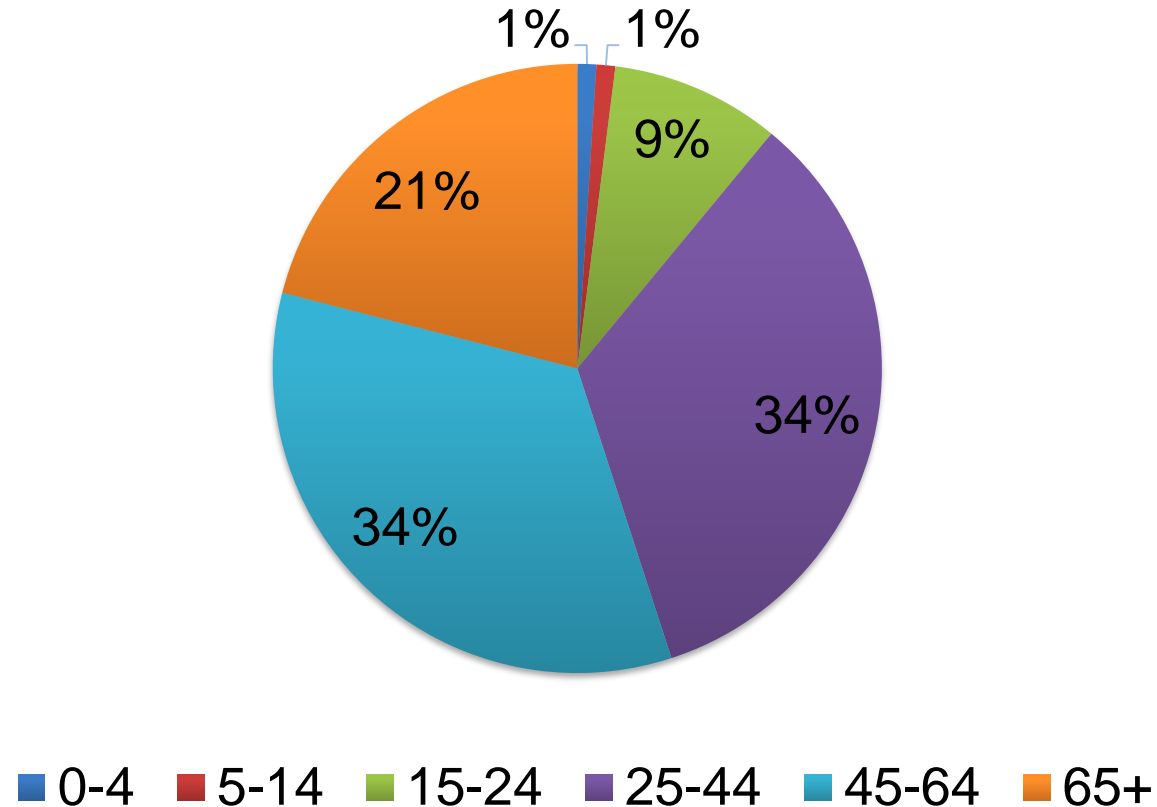

Tuberculosis by Age Group Florida, 2017 (N=549)



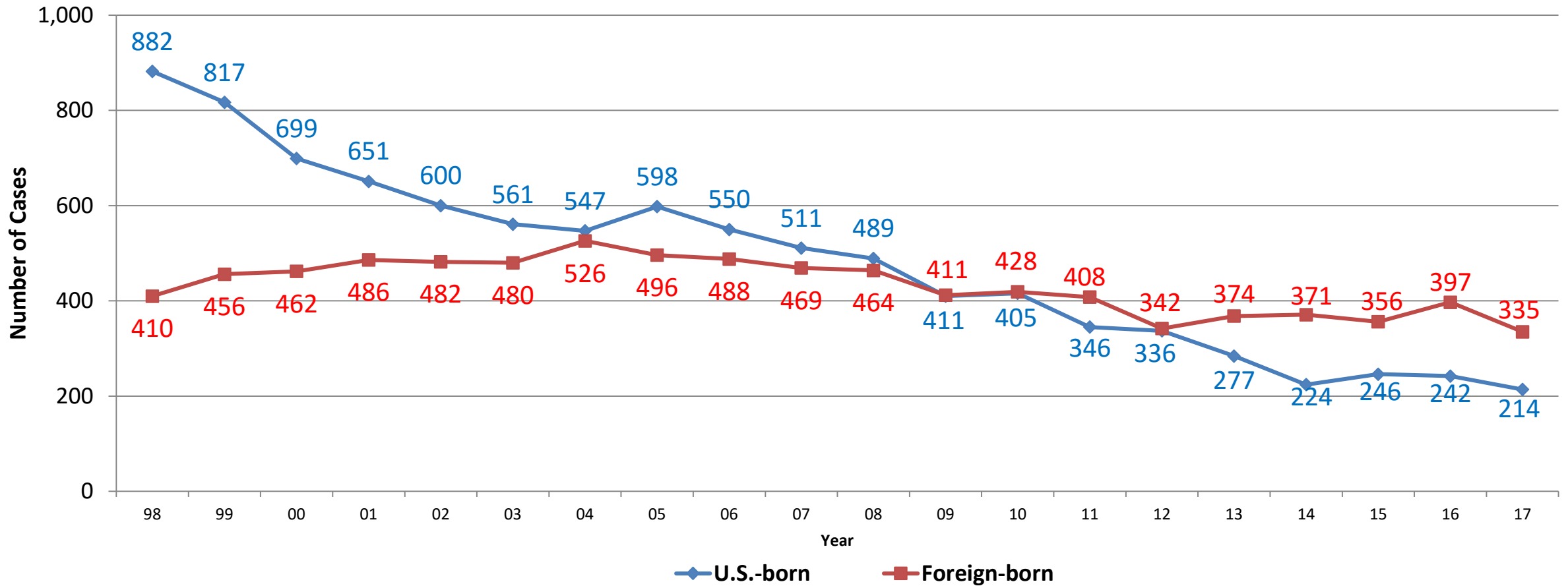

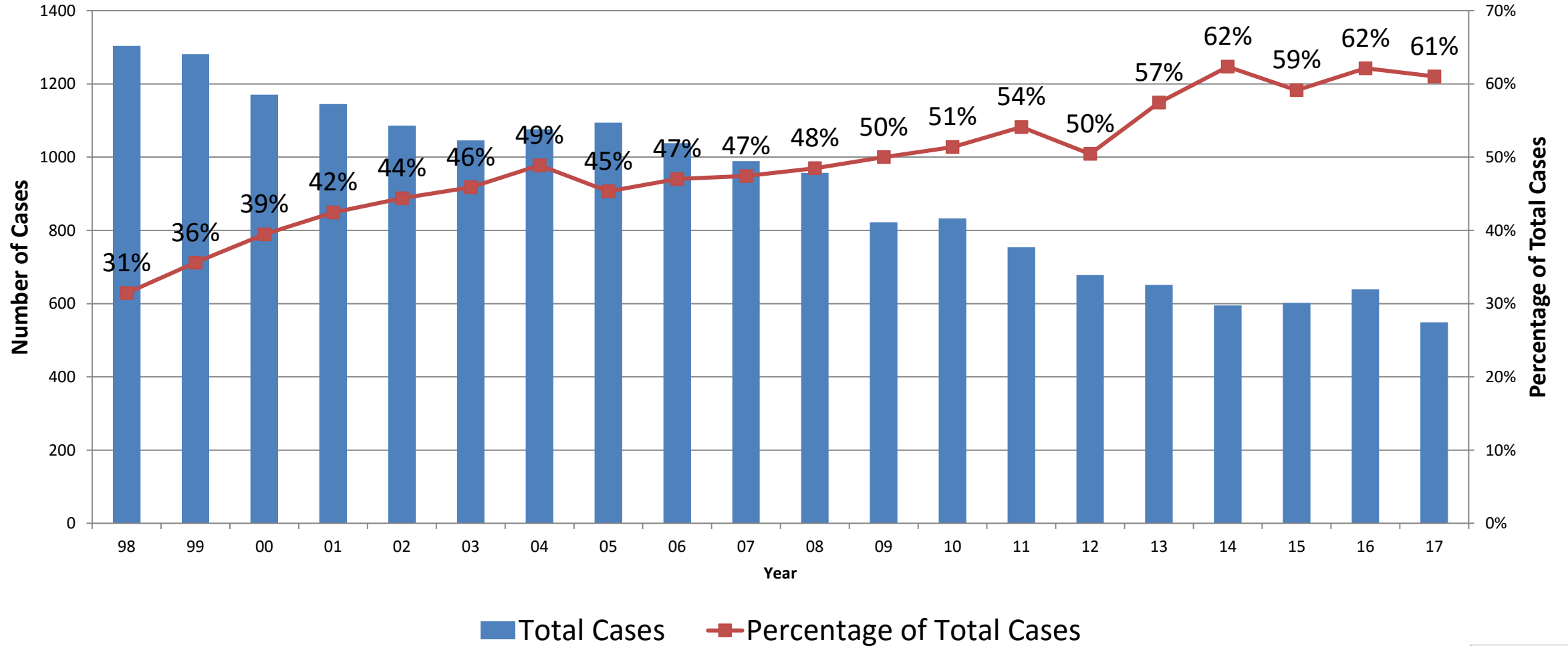

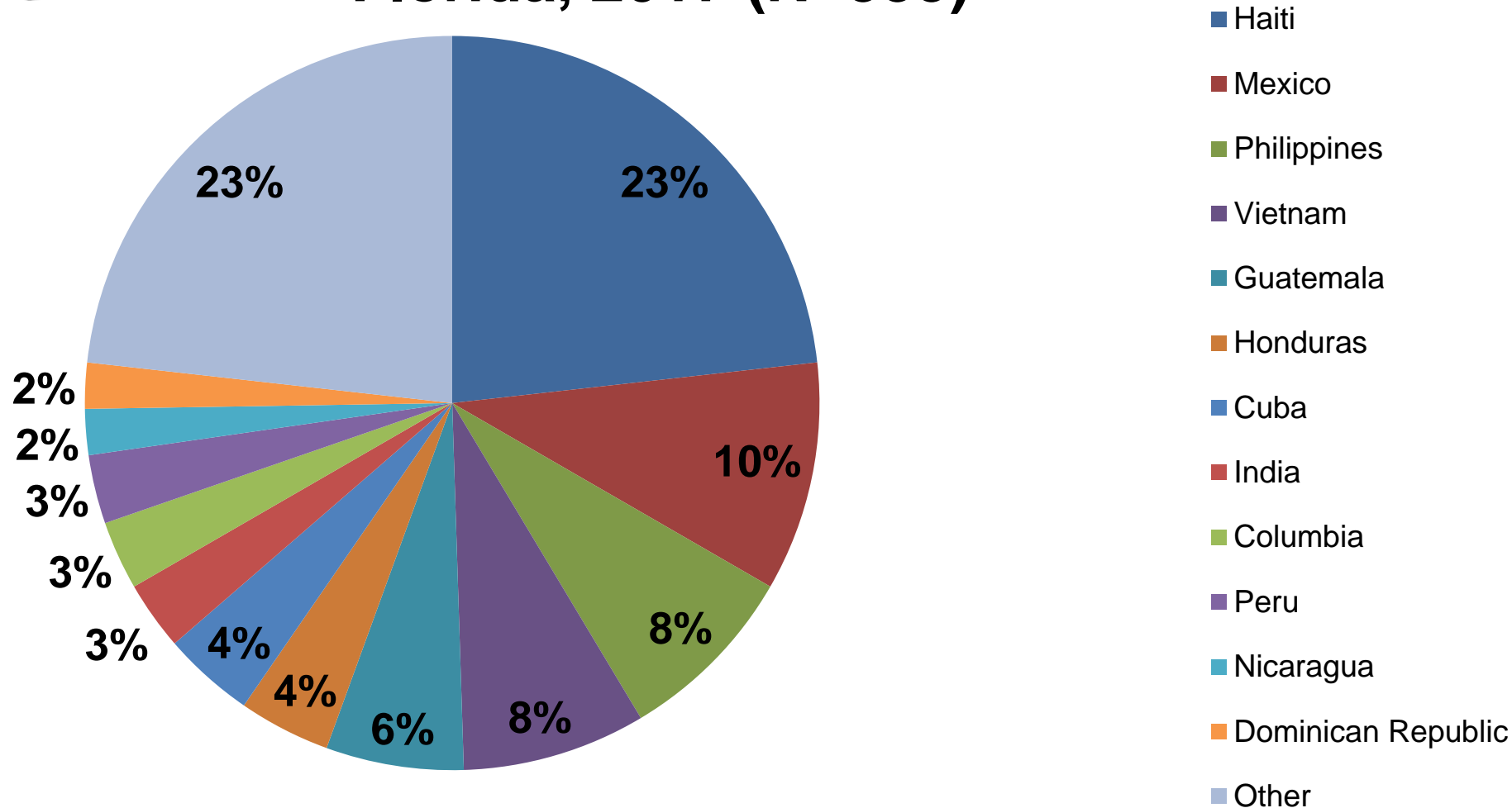

Foreign-born TB by Country of Birth Florida, 2017 (N=335)

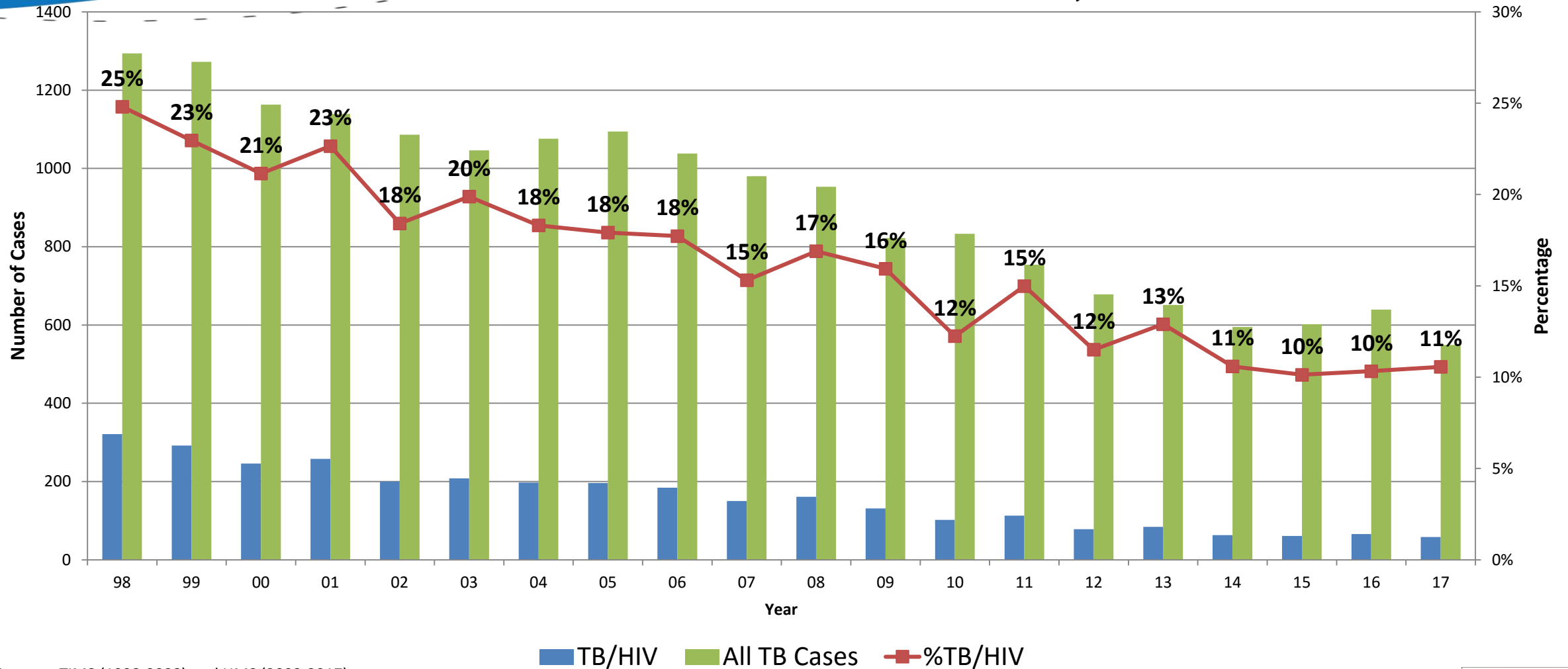

Tuberculosis/HIV Co-infection Florida, 1998-2017



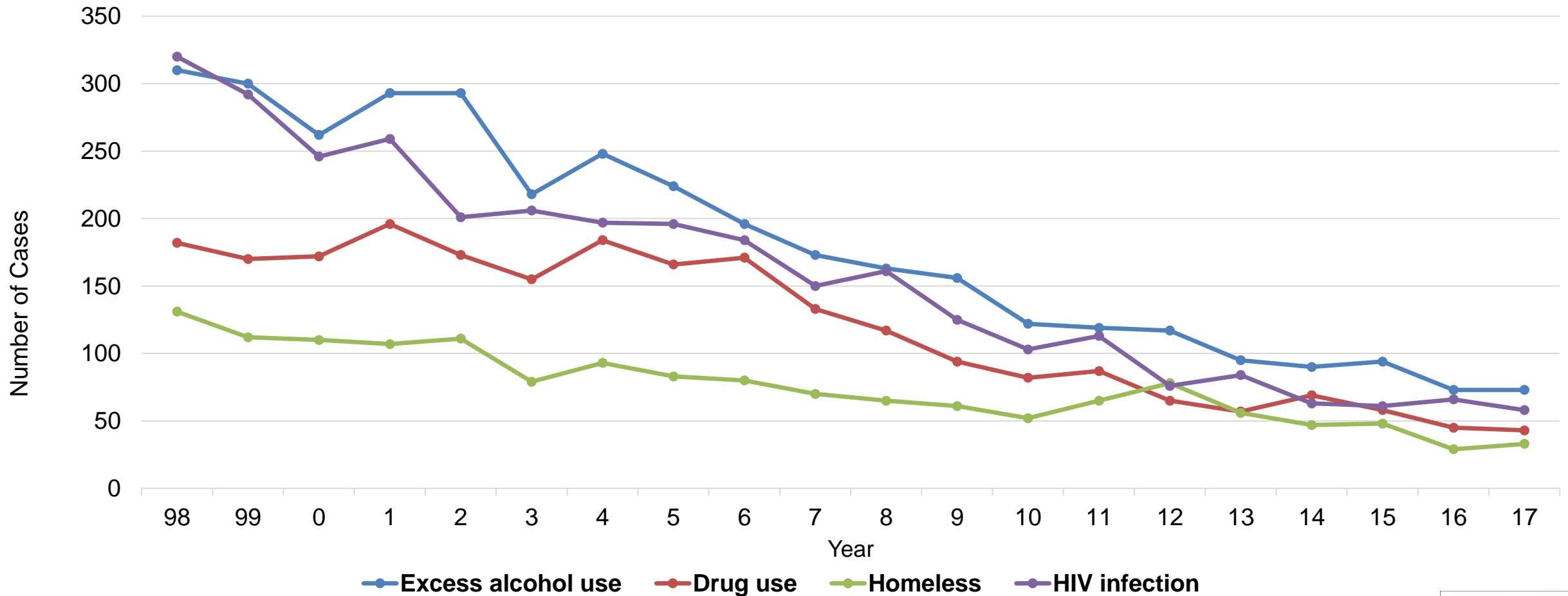

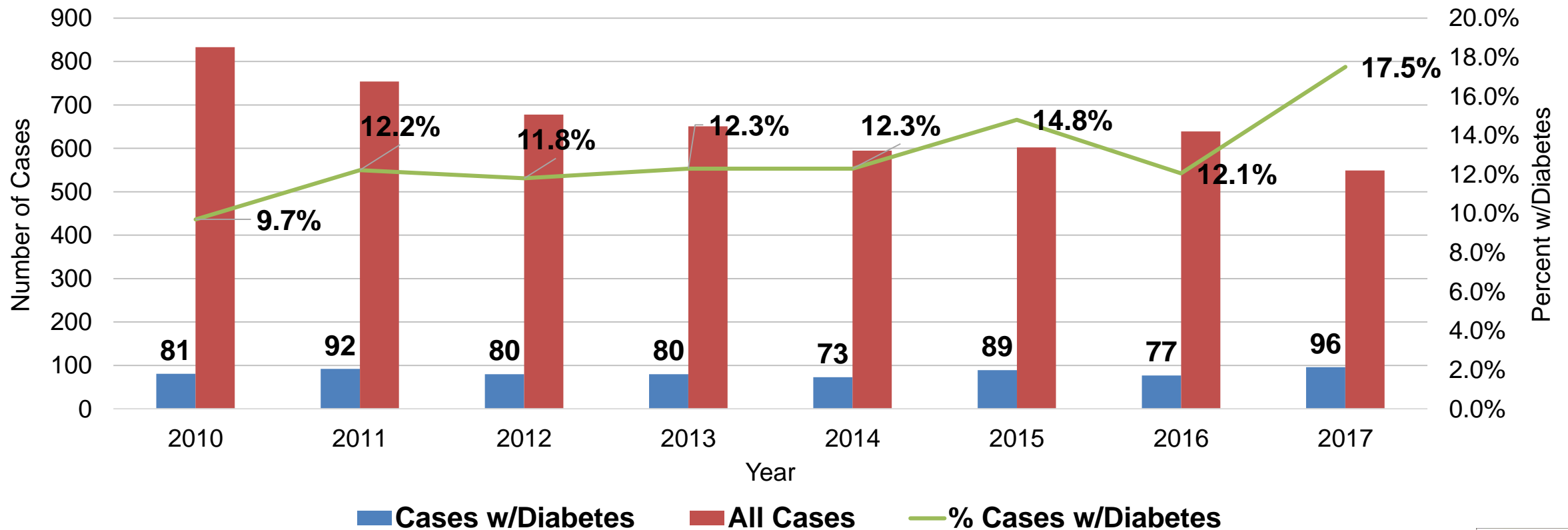

Florida, 2010 - 2017

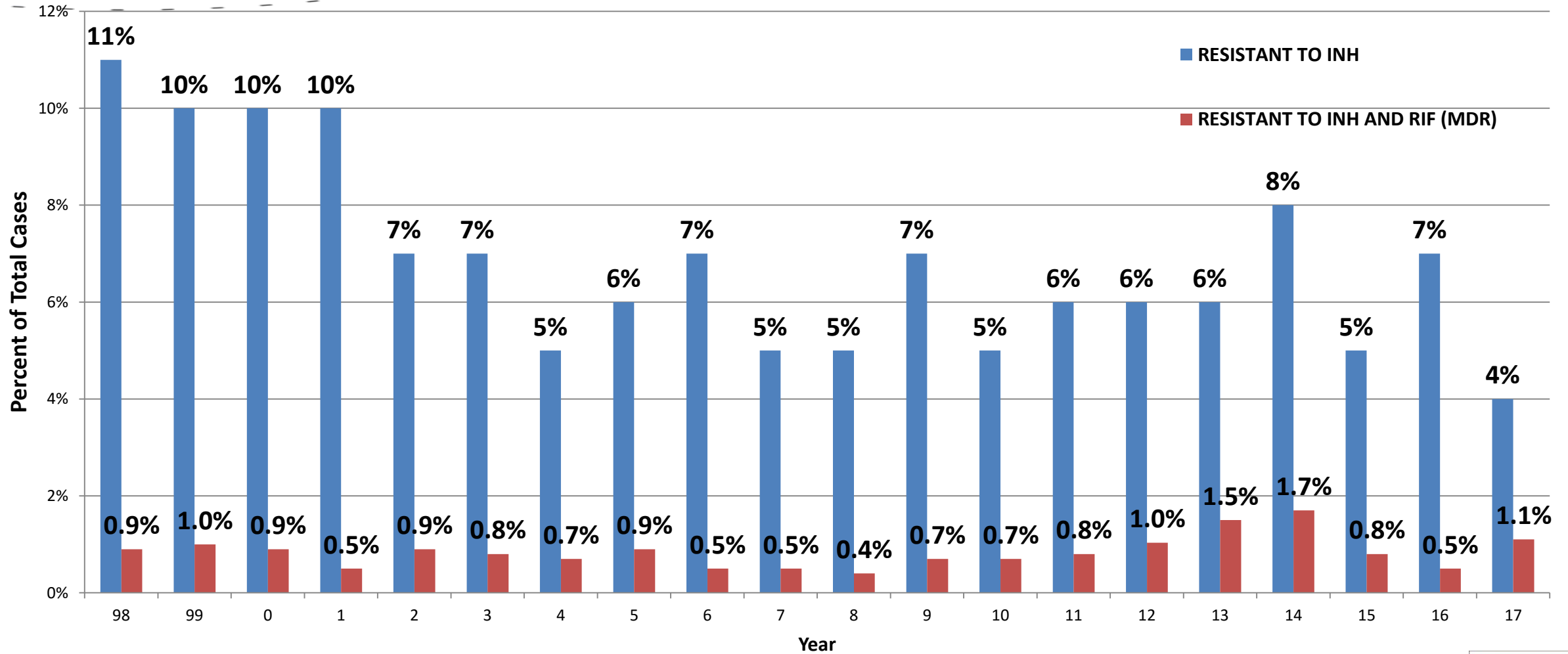
